## Upcoming IFIGS Survey on Recourse Practices and Policyholder Protection

The Fund of Guaranteeing Insurance Payments of the Republic of Uzbekistan, with the support of the Korea Deposit Insurance Corporation (KDIC), will conduct a survey among IFIGS members on recourse and subrogation practices, as well as mechanisms for protecting policyholders in the event of insurer insolvency.



The survey aims to collect and compare information on the legal and institutional frameworks governing recourse claims, claims management practices, cooperation with supervisory authorities, liquidators and other relevant institutions, and the measures used to protect policyholders when an insurance company becomes insolvent.

The findings will contribute to the exchange of experience among IFIGS members and help identify effective international practices that may support the further development of insurance guarantee systems.

The questionnaire is expected to be circulated on September 18, 2026. IFIGS members are kindly invited to submit their completed responses by October 18, 2026..

## Toronto Centre Virtual Workshop: Building Insurance Resilience to Climate Change

The Toronto Centre will present a two-half-day virtual workshop titled **“Building Insurance Resilience to Climate Change Workshop”** on **15–16 September 2026**. It will highlight the **benefits of insurance guarantee schemes** and the **importance of policyholder protection** as a central component of an effective financial services safety net and a key element in an effective resolution framework.

This workshop focuses on the design principles of Policyholder Protection/Insurance Guarantee Schemes (IGSs), their integration into resolution frameworks, and how climate risk is escalating insurance solvency risks. The program is of particular relevance for supervisors in jurisdictions that do not yet have such mechanisms in place and are looking to understand best practice, key design principles as well as the increasing relevance of such mechanisms in the context of a rapidly changing climate with increasing solvency risk.

## Recent Events

### Strengthening Regional Cooperation: IPGF Uzbekistan and IPGF Kazakhstan Sign Memorandum of Cooperation

On April 7, 2026, the **Fund of Guaranteeing Insurance Payments of the Republic of Uzbekistan** and **JSC Insurance Payments Guarantee Fund of the Republic of Kazakhstan** signed a **Memorandum of Cooperation** in Almaty.

The purpose of the Memorandum is to **strengthen cooperation, enhance mutual understanding, and coordinate the Parties' efforts in areas of common interest.**



The main areas of cooperation include the exchange of knowledge, analytical materials, and best practices; the organization of joint seminars, conferences, and training programs; conducting research on matters related to stability in the insurance sector; and the exchange of statistical data.

The Parties also intend to **promote awareness of the role of insurance protection mechanisms and their importance in maintaining insurance market stability.** The implementation of the Memorandum is expected to strengthen professional ties between the two organizations and contribute to the further development of the insurance payment guarantee systems in both countries.
